Over the summer, we celebrated another year of outstanding GCSE success, with almost 60% of results being the top 9-7 grades. The boys' results were well deserved, coming on the back of three years of great uncertainty and challenge for all in education.

There were a number of stand out performances, with Janik, Arsh, Aditya and Tim achieving straight 9 grades and Chris, James, Rahul and Samee achieving at least 9 grade 9s. Indeed, 42 of our wonderful boys got at least one of those coveted Grade 9s. 9 boys achieved an A* in the Higher Project Qualification – an optional extension project which promotes individual intellectual inquiry.
